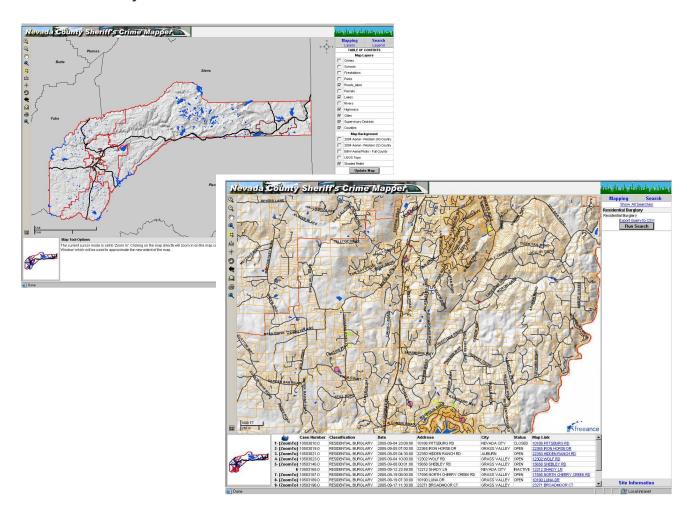




Nevada County CA



Our first Freeance site was designed for the Sheriff's Department using the Public Access Client with Freeance Direct. It has all the basic map elements (layer control, identify/selections, parcel number, site address, owner name, and street name searches) and also contains several specialized queries. These queries actually hit their "live" Records Management System (RMS), which contains all of the up-to-date reported crimes. They can run the searches and then click the 'Show on Map' link because we've setup Freeance Direct geocoding to our parcels layer (the address field).

Periodically, we will summarize the crime data from their RMS database and create a shapefile through geocoding in ArcMap. We load this information into the Freeance site, so that they can use buffers (that are setup in this site) to select all crimes by their Beats for a given time period. They can then export this data as a CSV/Excel file or print out the list for reporting purposes.
